
NOTIFICATION

Whereas it has come to the notice of the undersigned that plying of trucks / trailers having more than 10 (ten) wheels carrying Iron ore, Chrome, Coal and other minerals on SH-09A from 2/0 Km at Khaira Bridge to 38/0 Km at Kusunpur on Cuttack-Chandabali road, are not only damaging the road, but also causing inconvenience to the general public and giving rise to the vehicular congestion on such route.

Now therefore, I Sri Kishore Kumar Mohanty, OAS, Collector & District Magistrate-cum-Chairman, RTA, Cuttack, being satisfied that it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience to restrict movement of such heavy commercial vehicles (trucks) on the above mentioned road, in exercise of powers conferred on me U/s 115 of MV Act, 1988 read with rule 173 of Orissa Motor Vehicles Rules, 1993, do hereby restrict.

1. Movement of heavy commercial vehicles (trucks) having 10 (ten) wheels or more, carrying iron ore or other minerals on SH-9A (from 2/0 Khaira Bridge to 38/0 Kusunpur on Cuttack-Chandabali road).
2. The restrictions, however will not be applicable to commercial vehicles used for essential services and for construction and repair of the road in the locality within Cuttack district.
3. The relaxation on plying of such vehicles on the above road will be in force from 11.00 P.M to 05.00 A.M. every day and will be applicable to vehicles engaged for local trips / carrying essential commodities.
4. It is further ordered that in exigencies of public service and if situation warrants to ply such vehicles during the restriction period, the concerned vehicle owners / firms / organizations will have to obtain prior permission from the concerned Collector & District Magistrate / Superintendent of Police for plying of heavy commercial vehicles.

THESE RESTRICTIONS WILL COME INTO FORCE FROM 08.00 A.M. OF 25TH MAY, 2010 TILL MIDNIGHT OF 24TH JUNE, 2010.
